

May 2021 Monthly Meeting

The monthly meeting for the Town of Casco was called to order by Chairman Joe Lukes on Thursday, May 20, at 7:00 pm. Present were Dennis Helwig and the Casco Town Board.

The clerk read the minutes from the April meeting. Barry made a motion to approve the minutes as read. Perry seconded the motion. Motion approved.

The treasurer gave her report with balances as follows; Checking-\$350,380.45 Cemetery-\$3,208.25 There were no deposits of interest. Perry made a motion to approve. Barry seconded. Motion carried.

Edie reported that Mike Smiley declined the planning commission membership. The Board will be looking for a new member.

Pat Veaser called and said that Harter's truck damaged his driveway. He wants \$700 to repair it but Harter's will only pay \$500. He said he might hire an attorney to fight this.

Casco Town received \$1,970.96 for the annual recycling grant.

Dennis Helwig gave a presentation on setting up a town website. The clerk will contact other municipalities on the website options that they are using.

Liquor license applications were presented for Moe's Corner, JW's Place, Cedar Valley Campground and the Rio Creek Fly-In. Barry made a motion to approve the applications and Perry seconded. Motion approved.

All bills were approved and signed. There were no outstanding bills.

For the County Board Report, Joe stated that Bug Tussel has scheduled August as a starting date for broadband services in the county. A grant for \$14,000 was received for beginner recreational ATV students. The state wanted to change wildlife damage claims, but the county board voted it down. The Nuclear Plant was purchased and will be decommissioned. This will bring about 200 jobs to the county.

The next WTA unit meeting will be held on Monday, May 24, at the fairgrounds in Luxemburg.

The next town meeting will be on Monday, June 28, at 7:00 pm. Barry made a motion to adjourn. Perry seconded. Meeting adjourned at 7:50 pm.
