

July Monthly Meeting 2021

The monthly meeting for the Town of Casco was called to order by Chairman Joe Lukes at 7:00 pm on Thursday, July 22. Present were Laura Dart and all members of the Casco Town Board.

The clerk read the minutes from the June meeting. Barry made a motion to approve the minutes as read and Perry seconded. Motion approved.

The treasurer reported a checking balance of \$335,422.14 Cemetery fund \$3,208.45 State grant account \$61,806.78 Deposits of Interest: Quarterly transportation Aid-\$30,005.19 Vertical Bridge Tower Fee-\$2,000.00 State of Wisconsin Fire Dues-\$5,038.22 Perry made a motion to approve the report and Barry seconded. Motion approved.

There was nothing to report for zoning or for garbage and recycling.

Laura Dart spoke about the new website she will be setting up for the Town. The 3 year domain subscription and registration will cost \$390.00. Her labor cost is \$40.00 an hour.

Work on the Elm Road Bridge is progressing on schedule. Joe talked to Brian Papham. He said that Scott Construction is ready to start work on the wedging and chip sealing of the town roads.

The County Board was contacted by Charter Communications. They want to partner up with Bugtussel by supplying fiber optics to homes that Bugtussel can't reach. They will apply for a grant to help cover costs.

Joe reported that Chuck Wagner resigned from the County Board. A replacement will be appointed. He also stated that only 41% of the County residents are fully vaccinated for Covid. This is below the state average.

Because of the high cost of building a new jail, the County Board has reached out to contractors for bids on repairing the existing jail. That process is underway.

All bills were approved and paid. Two outstanding bills for Luxemburg Fire and Rescue are still unpaid. The clerk will send out 2nd notices.

The next Wisconsin Town's Association meeting is Monday, August 16 at 7:30 pm in Pierce Town. The next monthly Town meeting will be Tuesday, August 24 at 7:00 pm.

Barry made a motion to adjourn and Perry seconded. Meeting adjourned at 7:45 pm.
