

## June 2021 Monthly Meeting

The monthly meeting for the Town of Casco was called to order by Chairman Joe Lukes on Monday, June 28, at 7:00 pm. Present were Bruce Quistorff, Pat Benes, Bill Lohrey, DJ Delebreaux, Sue LaCrosse and all members of the Casco Town Board.

The clerk read the minutes from the May meeting. Barry made a motion to approve the minutes as read. Perry seconded. Motion carried.

The treasurer reported a checking balance of \$313,151.37 Cemetery fund \$3,208.35 Deposits of Interest-DNR payment in lieu of taxes \$573.26 Liquor license payments \$660.00 2021 Recycling grant \$1,970.96 Managed Forest Land \$347.13 First half of American Rescue Plan \$61,806.78 State of Wisconsin Personal property aid distribution \$368.24 Perry made a motion to approve the report and Barry seconded. Motion approved.

DJ Delebreaux presented a Certified Survey Map. Barry made a motion to approve and Perry seconded. Motion carried.

There was a rezone hearing for Sue LaCrosse on Joe Pagel's house. The Board questioned two trailers that are there. She said they will be removed. The plan commission voted unanimously to approve the rezone. Barry made a motion to approve and Perry seconded. Motion carried.

Bill Lohrey wants to combine 3 lots into 1. Barry made a motion to approve the request and Perry seconded. Motion carried.

Joe Delebreaux was recommended as a new plan commission member to replace Brian Dauck. Perry made a motion to approve and Barry seconded. Motion carried.

Pat Veeseer made a settlement with Harter's for \$500 for damage they caused to his driveway. Joe talked to Laura Dart about a website for the Town. Barry made a motion to hire her and Perry seconded. The clerk will call her for price quotes.

All bills were approved and paid. There were two bills for unreimbursed accidents with Luxemburg Fire and Rescue. The clerk will send out bills for collection.

Work on the Elm Road Bridge will begin on July 7 through August 28.

Casco Town will receive \$123,000 from the American Rescue Plan. It has yet to be decided how to use this grant. The Town will put the money in a separate account until a decision is made.

The County Fair is July 8-11. Sunday admission will be free. The County Highway Committee will be mailing out letters to residents near the curves on County C for input on the possibility of rumble strips.

DJ Delebreaux asked about decreasing the speed limit on County C and Rockledge Road. Joe said that 45 mph is as low as the state sets for that type of roadway.

The next meeting will be on Thursday, July 22, at 7:00 pm. Barry made a motion to adjourn and Perry seconded. Meeting adjourned at 8:05 pm.
