

August 2022 Monthly Meeting

The monthly meeting for the Town of Casco was called to order by Chairman Joe Lukes on Monday, August 22, at 7:00 pm. Present were Joe Mastalir, Greg Gabriel and all members of the Casco Town Board.

The clerk read the minutes from the July meeting. Barry made a motion to approve the minutes as read and Perry seconded. Motion carried.

The treasurer reported as follows: Checking-\$390,913.69 Cemetery-\$3,209.60 ARPA fund-\$123,680.78 Loan balance-\$34,595.50 Deposits of Interest: August settlement-\$72,007.70 Perry made a motion to approve the report and Barry seconded. Motion approved.

Edie stated that there will be 3 zoning hearings coming up for Baudhuin Farms, Baumgartner and Obry.

Joe talked about the Town Law Conference that will be held virtual only. There is a segment on nuisance properties.

All bills were approved and paid.

An outstanding bill from Dorothy Fulton was collected. 4 new outstanding bills from Luxemburg Fire & Rescue will be sent out by the clerk.

Liquor licenses were approved for the 2nd annual Casco Thresheree to be held August 27-28.

The County Board unanimously approved the purchase of body cameras for police officers in the county. A grant for \$61,000 will be used leaving the county to pay \$30,000. The cameras last about 3 years.

Joe talked about fishing on the Clyde Hill Bridge. There are concerns that it is too narrow for big equipment to pass through when people are fishing from lawn chairs. The measure was tabled for now.

Terrie and Peggy will be attending the fall workshop at Rock Gardens in Green Bay. Joe, Edie and Terrie will be attending the state convention in Appleton.

The next meeting will be held on September 22 at 7:00 pm. Barry made a motion to adjourn and Perry seconded. Meeting adjourned at 7:45 pm.
