June 2023 Monthly Meeting

The treasurer reported as follows: Checking-\$280,737.75 Cemetery- \$3,515.37 ARPA- \$86,153.97 CD-\$50,533.20 Deposits of Interest-Recycling Grant-\$1,967.05 MFL- \$358.53 Perry made a motion to approve the report and Barry seconded. Motion approved.

Edie reported that letters were delivered to Al Thiry and Holly Gruetzmaker by the sheriff's department. Fines will be assessed starting June 15 at \$10.00 per day for 30 days and starting July 15 at \$50.00 a day till issues resolved.

All bills were approved and paid. There are no outstanding bills.

Ditch mowing by the county should begin next week. This will be the first cut.

Tracy Nollenberg reported that Clean Sweep will be held on October 21 at the fairgrounds in Luxemburg.

Joe reported that Governor Evers signed a bill to increase shared revenues for municipalities and counties in the state.

The head of the veteran's service office in the county retired.

A county government survey was sent to selected individuals and it showed the greatest need was for road improvements.

Joe received some calls for fireworks permits and was told by the Luxemburg Fire Department to not issue any unless we received a substantial amount of rain before the July 4th holiday.

Barry made a motion to adjourn and Perry seconded. Meeting adjourned at 7:45 pm.
