March Monthly Meeting

The monthly meeting for the Town of Casco was called to order by Chairman Joe Lukes on Tuesday, March 28, at 6:00 pm. Present were Bruce Quistorff and all members of the Casco Town Board. The clerk read the minutes from the February meeting. Perry made a motion to approve the minutes as read and Joe seconded. Motion carried.

The treasurer reported as follows; Checking-\$306,339.84 Cemetery-\$3,513.18 ARPA fund-\$85,936.05 Amount to pay off the loan balance-\$35,198.31 DOI-none Perry made a motion to approve the report and Joe seconded. Motion approved.

There were no zoning issues to report.

Harters did not pick up by Barb Jadin again so Joe called Harters. They said they would speak to the driver to fix the problem.

Jake LeFave offered to do the lawn care at the cemetery for \$1,750.00 for the year. Perry made a motion to accept his bid and Barry seconded. Motion carried.

Bruce Quistorff suggested doing some tree trimming by Rockledge Road and Townline Road to improve visibility. Joe said they would check it out.

The County Board met with Economic Development and they determined that the housing shortage was the number one priority and education was number two in the county. A career day at Pagel's Farm will be held on April 18 and 19. More than 900 students are expected to attend.

Tim Kinnard sent out a letter stating that the Village of Casco will be applying for a grant for free well testing due to high nitrate levels in village wells. In addition, the County will be offering free well testing on July 11 and October 17. Registration begins about a month before.

All bills were approved and paid by the board.

Election workers for the April election will be Edie Lauscher, Joy Kruse, and Barb Porath.

Open book will be held on April 15 from 10 am till noon at the town hall. Board of Review will be on Tuesday, April 25 from 6-8 pm. The annual meeting will be held on Thursday, April 27, at 6:30 pm to be immediately followed by the monthly town meeting.

Perry made a motion to adjourn and Barry seconded. Meeting adjourned at 6:50 pm.
