

## December 2022 Monthly Meeting

The monthly meeting for the Town of Casco was called to order on Thursday, December 15, at 6:00 pm by Chairman Joe Lukes. Present were Fran Pavlat, Linda Fenendael, Greg Gabriel and all members of the Casco Town Board.

The clerk read the minutes from the November meeting. Barry made a motion to approve the minutes as read and Perry seconded. Motion carried.

The treasurer reported as follows: Checking-\$256,127.59 Cemetery-\$3,511.11 ARPA fund-\$123,861.23 Loan balance-\$34,595.50 D.O.I-State of Wisconsin LRIP project-\$13,651.68 Perry made a motion to approve the report and Barry seconded. Motion approved.

Edie reported that Holly Gruetzmacher was served papers on November 21 by the sheriff's department to clean up her property. Joe checked on the cleanup progress by Al Thiry. He noticed that vehicles and riding lawn mowers have been removed and it appears he is cleaning up the property.

The clerk reported that Jason Baierl paid \$50.00 on his outstanding bill. He was sent a letter to continue payments or legal action will be taken. Robin Urban has not paid his bill in full so it will be placed on his taxes.

A contract was received from Beining Building Inspection for 2023-2025. Perry made a motion to sign the contract and Barry seconded. Contract was signed.

A motion was made by Perry to use \$68,943.14 of the ARPA funds to pay Luxemburg Fire and Rescue for the Town's portion of a new fire truck tender and to pay part of the Luxemburg Fire and Rescue assessment for 2023. Joe seconded the motion. Motion approved. Peggy will transfer the money from the ARPA fund to the Town checking account.

Garbage and recycling calendars for 2023 will be included in the tax bills. Extras will be kept on hand at the Town Hall.

The next meeting will be held on Tuesday, January 24, at 7:00 pm. Barry made a motion to adjourn and Perry seconded. Meeting adjourned at 6:30 pm.
