

May Monthly Meeting 2024

The monthly meeting for the Town of Casco was called to order by Supervisor Perry Pavlat on Tuesday, May 28, at 7:00 pm. Present were Brian Paplham, Pat Benes, Brooke and Matt Bowman, Al Meister, Eric Oshefsky and members of the Casco Town Board. Chairman Joe Lukes was absent due to illness.

The clerk read the minutes from the April meeting. Barry made a motion to approve the minutes as read and Perry seconded. Motion carried.

The treasurer reported as follows; Checking- \$360,170.40 Cemetery-\$122.41 ARPA-\$87,200.77
Checking CD-\$52,550.28 Cemetery CD-\$4,048.37 D.O.I.-Dog license refund from County- \$1,587.94
Recycling grant- \$1,969.47 Personal property aid -\$368.24 Peggy also stated that the Government Investment Pool was not available to towns. Barry made a motion to approve the report and Perry seconded. Motion carried.

Edie had a CSM for the Norman Oshefsky property. They are selling 29.3 acres including the house, barn and orchard. Barry made a motion to sign the CSM and Perry seconded. The clerk signed the form.

Wes Fager appeared before the Board asking if he could move an old house trailer on his property, remove the wheels, and make it into a storage building. Perry asked Edie about an ordinance regarding house trailers. The Board decided to table the issue until the next meeting so that they could view the property and trailer.

Randy Hallet resigned as a Board of Appeals member. Barry made a motion to appoint Ken Malcore to the Board to replace Randy. Perry seconded. Motion carried.

All bills were approved and paid. There are no outstanding bills.

Brian Paplham talked about quotes for roadwork for 2024. Barry made a motion to approve 4 of the 5 road repair bids at a cost of \$155,714.00. Perry seconded. Barry also made a motion to apply the remaining ARPA funds of \$85,170.56 to be applied toward the cost of the roadwork and Perry seconded. Motion carried.

Liquor license applications were presented to the Board. Barry made a motion to approve the applications and Perry seconded. Motion carried.

The sheriff's department and the Town of Luxemburg want to reduce the speed limit on Sunset road to 45 mph. Barry made a motion to lower the speed limit to 45 mph and Perry seconded. Motion carried.

The Town Board updated the list of town businesses. The clerk will report to the sheriff's department. The clerk explained the Maintenance of Effort report which is due to the DOR by July 1. These are annual reports received from fire and EMS.

Pat Benes asked about any changes at Holly Gruetzmacher's residence. It appears that some cleanup has been done. He also noted that some road signs are faded and need to be replaced. The Board will check these out.

The next meeting is scheduled for Thursday, June 27 at 7:00 pm. Barry made a motion to adjourn and Perry seconded. Meeting adjourned at 8:10 pm.
