

## July 2022 Monthly Meeting

The monthly meeting for the Town of Casco was called to order by Chairman Joe Lukes on Tuesday, July 26, at 7:00 pm. Present were Joe Mastalir and all members of the Casco Town Board.

The clerk read the minutes from the June meeting. Barry made a motion to approve the minutes as read and Perry seconded. Motion carried.

The treasurer reported as follows: Checking-\$400,714.38 Cemetery-\$3,209.39 ARPA fund-\$123,656.82 Loan balance-\$40,989.85 Deposits of Interest: General transportation aid-\$30,610.31 2% fire dues-\$5,047.49 July shared revenue-\$8,227.08 SBA cell tower fee-\$2,000.00 Exempt computer aid-\$41.57 Perry made a motion to approve the report and Barry seconded. Motion carried.

Edie reported that the Board of Appeals had a hearing on the Nathan Havel property. He requested a conditional use permit to build a shed. 4 out of 5 members approved the request. Motion carried.

All bills were approved and paid. The Fulton fire bill is still outstanding. Joe received a letter from Robin Urban requesting that his home be reassessed due to a fire causing a total loss. A letter will be sent to the assessor.

Joe reported on the TRIP project on Maple Sugar Lane. He received a bid proposal from Jadin, Inc. for adding gravel, grading and rolling at a cost of \$10,175.00. Perry made a motion to approve the bid from Jadin and Barry seconded. Motion approved. He also reported on a bid from Scott Construction for double chip sealing at \$24,529.00. Perry made a motion to approve the bid and Barry seconded. Motion approved.

Joe attended a meeting with the Luxemburg Fire Department. They reported that a turbo went out on a ladder truck. The cost to repair is \$5,932.00, The department also applied for ARPA funds. They will receive \$24,390 to use as needed.

Joe reported that the County Board approved the building of the new jail at a cost of 25.6 million dollars.

Joe Mastalir reported on the Thresheree to be held in August. Village Kitchen will cater the food and the Dykesville Lions will serve beverages.

Election workers for the August 9 election will be Nancy Smiley, Terrie Gabriel and Edie Lauscher.

The WTA state convention will be held in Appleton on October 9-11. More about the convention will be discussed in August.

The next quarterly unit meeting will be held on Monday, August 15, at the Montpelier town hall. The next town meeting will be held on Monday, August 22 at 7:00 pm.

Barry made a motion to adjourn and Perry seconded. Meeting adjourned at 7:50 pm.
